IRWIN — Cora Mae Campbell, daughter of Marcus and Rachel Hansen Axland was born Jan. 30, 1903 near Irwin. She attended Polk No. 8 rural school.

Aug. 14, 1929, she married Maurice R. Campbell at Avoca. They had farmed since Feb. 1930, on Maurice's grandfather's home place; this had been their home since that time. She was a life long member of the St. Paul's Lutheran Church. She died Dec. 28, 1991, at the Jennie Edmundson Hospital in Co. Bluffs, at age 88 years, 10 months and 28 days.

She was preceded in death by her parents; a brother, Henry Axland and three sisters, Emelia Nelson, Elva Guth and Gladys Rogers. Survivors include her husband, Maurice of Irwin; a daughter, Marjorie (Robert) Ahrenholtz of Harlan; a nephew, Marwin Rogers of Hordville, NE., who made his home with them from 1951 to 1958; a brother, Elmer Axland of Manning and two sisters, Ola Sleister of Manilla and Nellie Ickes of Irwin; three grandchildren; five great-grandchildren; nieces and nephews and other relatives.
