## **Agnete Valborg Carlsen, 90**

**Sept. 6, 1904 - Oct. 28, 1994**

**Audubon** - Agnete Valborg Carlsen, daughter of Carl C. and Jorgine (Jorgensen) Carlsen, was born near Kirkman, Sept. 6, 1904. As a small child, she moved with her parents to western KS. This was their home until 1910 when they moved back to Shelby County, where her parents were stewards of the county home. In 1912, they moved to Avoca for a short time before moving to Guthrie Center. They then returned to Shelby County, settling on a farm east of Harlan. While growing up, she was baptized and confirmed in the Lutheran faith. She attended school at Rabbit Hollow in Center Township and graduated from Harlan High School in 1924 before going to Danebord College in Tyler, MN. She grew to adulthood on the farm and then helped her parents. She has lived with her sister Verna for a number of years. After becoming ill last Dec. and her short stay in the hospital, she became a resident of the Friendship Home in Audubon in Jan. of this year. This had been her home since that time. She died Oct. 28, 1994 at

the Audubon County Hospital at age 90 years, one month and 22 days.

She was preceded in death by her parents and a brother Harold. She is survived by her brothers - Halvor Carlsen of Sun Valley, CA and Wilmer Carlsen of Polson, MT; her sisters - Thelma (Peter) Knudsen of Sanford, FL and Verna Adams of Manilla; her nieces and nephews and other relatives.

Funeral services were held Nov. 2, 1994 at the First United Methodist Church in Harlan with Rev. Paul Wilcox officiating. Burial was in the Harlan cemetery with Alvin Adams, Bruce Adams, Galen Adams, Bob Adams, Jack Borkowski and Allan Adams casket bearers. Pauley Funeral Home in charge of arrangements.
