

Kenneth E. Conrad, 67

Feb. 3, 1927 - May 21, 1994

Harlan - Kenneth Eldon Conrad was born to Arthur and Toy (Erickson) Conrad Feb. 3, 1927 in Shelby County near Harlan. He attended country school at Lincoln #4 where he graduated from the eighth grade. After graduating he farmed with his father Art, and brother Alvin. He and Alvin also built several buildings and barns in the area. Kenneth worked during the winter time for Green Bay Lumber Company, helped his father with a Tree Service and was always ready to help area farmers.

Aug. 20, 1949 he married Lenora Flug of Irwin at Hiawatha, KS. To this union seven children were born. After they were first married they farmed the home place, with brother Alvin, then moved to the farm which they presently reside on in 1968. They farmed in Lincoln Township for 45 years. He attended the Immanuel Lutheran Church where his wife was a member. He died May 21, 1994 at Clarkson Hospital in Omaha at age 67 years, three months and 18 days.

Preceding him in death were his parents, stepmother Rosetta Walters, three brothers Mervin, Dale, and Victor. He is survived by his wife, Lenora of Harlan; his children - Sharon (Arlyn) Oman of Kirkman, Dale (Beth Ann) Conrad of Harlan, Charles (Jonelle) Conrad of Harlan, Sandra (Leo) Green of Harlan, Dennis Conrad of Harlan, Pamela (Jordan) Larsen of Kimballton, Lisa Conrad of Harlan; thirteen grandchildren; and two brothers Alvin Conrad and Dewey (Ruby) Conrad both of Harlan, and other relatives.
