Dec. 13, 1918 – April 19, 2001

OAKLAND – Dale Earl Cain, son of James Earl and Catherine Shrive Cain, was born Dec. 13, 1918, in Belgrade, NE, and died April 19, 2001, at his home in Oakland, at age 82 years. He attended Belgrade School and Feb. 8, 1942 was inducted into the Army Air Corps. While in the Army Air Corps he was stationed in many places in the United States and England. After being discharged from the Air Corps, he worked around Southwest Iowa doing construction.

June 30, 1948, he married Dorothy Helen Massey. Three children were born to this union, Teresa, Michael and Dana. They lived in Oakland until her death Jan. 3, 1997. He continued to live in Oakland.

Jan. 24, 1998, he married Gaile Looper. He remained in Oakland until the time of his death. He was a member of the Wheeler Grove Church, the VFW and a former member of the American Legion.

Dale's first wife, Dorothy; parents; brothers, Orville Cain and Merlin "Spike" Cain; and sisters, Inez Hinton and Irene Johnston, precede him in death.
