## Beulah A. Campbell, 84

Aug. 7, 1912 - April 17, 1997

**HARLAN** - Beulah Aline Campbell was born Aug. 7, 1912, in Atlantic. She was the daughter of Jesse S. and Maude W. Shultz Campbell, one of five children in the family. The family moved to Harlan, where they lived for a time and then moved to Avoca. She attended school in Avoca, through the 10th grade and afterward taught dancing in Omaha, NE, and other parts of the country before returning to this area and making her home with her twin sister, Betty Diggle, in Shelby. She also lived in Harlan at the Country Care Center and was living at the Baptist Memorial Home prior to her death. She died April 17, 1997, at Myrtue Memorial Hospital at age 84 years, eight months and 10 days.

She was preceded in death by her parents and one brother, Warren Campbell. She is survived by her two sisters, her twin, Betty Diggle, and Jessie Kendrick both of Shelby; one brother, Bill Campbell (Ethel) of Harlan; nieces, nephews and other relatives.

Funeral services were held April 21, 1997, at the Knutson Funeral Chapel with Pastor Stan Nielsen officiating. Burial was in the Neola Cemetery. Knutson Funeral Home in charge of arrangements.
