

## Clarence C. Campbell, 92

*Nov. 28, 1908 – Feb. 16, 2001*

**IRWIN** – Clarence Clyde Campbell was born Nov. 28, 1908, to Martha (Magnus) and Milton Campbell in Greeley Township, Shelby County. He graduated from Defiance High School.

He married Nina Potts March 5, 1934, in Rockwell City, and has resided on farms in the Defiance area during all of his married life. He lived on the couple's present farm since 1943. They were blessed with three children, Peggy, Gary and Clarice. A member of the United Methodist Church in Irwin, he also held memberships in Sardijs Lodge No. 444, A.F. & A.M.
