

Edythe Arlene Campbell, 81

Feb. 20, 1919 – Aug. 3, 2000

DEFIANCE, – Edythe Arlene Campbell, daughter of James A. and Edith P. (Woods) Campbell, was born Feb. 20, 1919, in rural Defiance. After attending Greeley #8 country school, she attended Irwin High School, and graduated in 1935. She then cared for her parents in their home until their deaths. Arlene and her brother, Floyd, continued living in their childhood home, caring for each other. Arlene died, Aug. 3, 2000, at Jennie Edmundson Memorial Hospital at age 81 years, 5 months, and 14 days.

Preceding her in death were her parents, and three brothers, Maurice Campbell, Ralph Campbell, and Howard Campbell. She is survived by one brother, Floyd Campbell of Defiance; two sisters-in-law, Irene Campbell and Edna Campbell, both of Irwin; nieces and nephews; and other relatives.

Funeral services were held Aug. 7, 2000, at the Burnmeister-Johannsen Funeral Home, with Rev. Joseph P. Boysen of the Irwin United Methodist Church, officiating. Casket bearers were Norman Campbell, Vernon Campbell, Marvin Campbell, Larry Campbell, Lyle Campbell, Robert Ahrenholtz, and Darrell Johnson. Burial was in the Oak Hill Cemetery in Irwin.
