DEFIANCE - Nina Irene Campbell, daughter of Charles and Myrtle (Puckett) Potts, was born Sept. 29, 1913, in Rose Bud County, MT. When she was five years old, she moved from Montana with her parents to a farm near Lake City, and lived there until her marriage. She attended school in Carroll and Calhoun County.

She married Clarence Campbell March 5, 1934, in Rockwell City, and they have lived on a farm around Defiance all of their married life. They were blessed with three children, Peggy, Gary and Clarice. She was a member of the United Methodist Church in Irwin, and also a member of the Order of Eastern Star of Irwin for 50 years. She died May 19, 1998, at Myrtue Memorial Hospital at age 84 years, seven months and 20 days.

In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by five brothers and three sisters. Survivors include her husband, Clarence Campbell of Defiance; her children, Peggy (Bill) Brue of Irwin; Gary (Daneen) Campbell of New Cumberland, PA; Clarice (Ron) Rubeck of Urbandale; four grandchildren; nine great grandchildren and other relatives.
