HARLAN – Victor Donald Carl, son of Edna (Richards) and Donald Carl, was born Jan. 1, 1919, in Irwin. Victor attended school in Harlan, and graduated from Harlan High School.

March 3, 1941, Victor entered the United States Army where he served his country during World War II. He was a member of the Army Band and served in the French-Morocco, Tunisian, Sicilian, Naples-Foggia and Rome-Arno Campaigns. He was honorably discharged June 17, 1945, after receiving five bronze stars and numerous other rewards. After his time in the service, Vic returned home where he was a member of the Earl Russell Orchestra with his brother. Victor died Nov. 21, 2002, at Myrtue Memorial Hospital at age 83 years, 10 months and 20 days.

He was preceded in death by his parents. He is survived by his brothers, Richard Carl of Harlan and Jack Carl (Verona) of Beaverton, OR; his nephews, Curtis Carl of Hays, KS; Bruce Carl (Kathleen) of Harlan; and Tom Carl (Judy) of Beaverton, OR; and other relatives.
