

Halvor Carlsen, 86

April 21, 1913 - March 19, 2000

SUN VALLEY, CA – Halvor Carlsen was born April 21, 1913, to Carl C. and Jorgine (Jorgensen) Carlsen. He attended country school through the eighth grade and then attended and graduated from Harlan High School. He helped at home on the family farm and was also a bee keeper for several years while at home. He worked his way to California doing various jobs.

He married Annabelle Cournoyer in 1945. She died in 1974. Before retirement he was a building inspector for the city of Los Angeles. He died March 19, 2000, at his home in Sun Valley, CA.

He was preceded in death by his parents; his wife, Annabelle in 1974; a sister, Agnete; and a brother, Harold.
