## **Dallas (Dean) Clausen, 57**

*July 15, 1943 – March 20, 2001*

**CHEROKEE** – Dallas (Dean) Clausen of Cherokee, formerly of Audubon, son of Arthur and Myrtle Jensen Clausen, was born July 15, 1943, in Audubon, and died of lung cancer March 20, 2001, in Oklahoma City, OK, at age 57. He was baptized and confirmed at Ebenezer Lutheran Church west of Audubon. He attended Audubon Community Schools and lived and worked in the Audubon and Harlan area. He worked 19 years for IBP in Des Moines and Cherokee. He spent the last three weeks of his life with his daughter in Oklahoma City.
