

**Alan Cullison, 72**

**May 18, 1936 - May 13, 2009**

**WEST HARTFORD, CT** — Alan D. Cullison of West Hartford, CT, passed away unexpectedly on Wednesday, May 13, 2009. He was born on May 18, 1936 in Harlan. Alan graduated from the University of Chicago with a B.S. in Mathematics, the University of Iowa School of Law with a J.D., and Yale University with a Master of Law degree. He was a Professor at the University of Connecticut School of Law from 1971 to 2004, and a Professor Emeritus of Law from 2004 to 2009. Alan pursued knowledge passionately all his life, never tiring of discovering and delving into new interests. Having been a loving, uplifting, and devoted husband, father, grandfather and brother, he is dearly missed.

Alan was preceded in death by his father, Bennett Cullison; brother, Bennett Cullison, Jr.; and mother, Anna May Cullison.
