

Glade G. Custer, 76

July 4, 1920 - Jan. 8, 1997

LAKESWOOD, CO - Glade G. Custer was born July 4, 1920 in Shelby County to Glen and Opal Custer (Goodner). He attended Corley Grade School and graduated from Harlan High School. He was in the Seabees in World War II.

He married Ila Mortensen and three children, Sharon, deceased; Jim, deceased, and Connie Tasker (Tony) of Lakewood, CO, were born to this union. He farmed several years with his father, Glenn Custer. He then worked in Omaha and did bulldozer work on the airfield in Lincoln, NE. They moved to Denver, CO in 1951 where he worked for Purina Feeds. He was the youngest to be added to Purina's Hall of Fame. He died Jan. 8, 1997, at a nursing home in Lakewood, CO.



He is survived by his daughter, Connie (Tony) Tasker of Lakewood, CO; brother, Ival (Marg) Custer; sister, Verlee (Pastor Wait) Bernard both of Harlan; brother-in-law, James (Donna) Mortensen of Oregon; sister-in-law, Marjorie (Ralph) Hansen of Harlan and other relatives.
