

## Everette N. Eggerss, 71

**AVOCA** - Everette Nicholas Eggerss was born in Pottawattamie county on July 2, 1916. He was the son of John and Amanda Maassen Eggerss. He was one of four children in the family. He attended school at Avoca and graduated with the class of 1934.

He married Rose Petersen on Dec. 21, 1941 at Benson, NE. They made their home on the same farm that he was born on. They were the parents of three daughters, LaDonna, Cheri and Vicki. He was a member of the Trinity Lutheran Church in Avoca. They retired from farming in 1987 and on Oct. of the same year they moved to Harlan. He died at the Crawford County Hospital in Denison on April 19, 1988 at age 71 years.
