LOGAN — Violet Kermish Garrett was born April 29, 1901 in Persia, daughter of Frank and Ann Kermish.

She married Bill Garrett, Nov. 26, 1919. She lived all her life in the Persia and Logan area. In March 1949 they moved into the home in Logan where they resided. She broke a hip Nov. 3, 1990 and was hospitalized. Later after suffering a stroke she entered the Westmont Care Center in Logan. She celebrated her 71st and 72nd wedding anniversaries while there and also her 90th and 91st birthdays. She died April 30, 1992.

Preceding her in death were a daughter, Arlene Alma; a son, Laverne Elmer and two brothers and a sister. Survivors include her husband, Bill of Logan; a daughter, Consuelo Mahan-Roundy of Co. Bluffs; four granddaughters; and nine great-grandchildren.

Funeral services were held at the Christian Church in Logan May 2 with Bill Stewart and Rusty Hedger, the clergymen. Bearers were Rex Gerratt, Ed Walkup, Virgil Carter, Murray Hubbard, Darrell Fahrenkrog and Laverne Wilson. Burial was in the Valley View cemetery at Persia, with arrangements by Schumacher Funeral Home.
