Harlan - Doris "Pat" Patsy Garvin, daughter of Clifford and Helen (Belts) Sutton was born July 18, 1937 in Bedford, and later baptized into the Christian faith. While growing up she helped her parents with their restaurants in AZ, MO, and IA.

Dec. 13, 1967 she married Roy Lee Garvin. Two daughters were born to this union. After their marriage they resided in Prescott, AZ where she became involved in raising their two daughters. As a family they traveled through AZ, MO, and later settled in IA. At age forty-five she was diagnosed with diabetes. Over the next several years she battled kidney problems and had been on dialysis since 1990. She died Aug. 17, 1995 at Bishop Clarkson Memorial Hospital at age fifty-eight years and thirty days.

Besides her parents, her brother, Larry, preceded her in death. She is survived by her daughters, Cherry (Ricky T.) Parkham and Louise Garvin both of Harlan; her three granddaughters; her brothers, Jerry (Sonja) Sutton of Myton, UT and Jim (La Nell) Sutton of Aztec, NM and other relatives.

A memorial service was held Aug. 19, 1995 at Pauley Funeral Home with Rev. Roger Crawford of Bethel Baptist Church in Harlan officiating.
