DEFIANCE - David Philip Graeve, the son of Philip and Harriett (Swanson) Graeve was born in Omaha, NE on Sept. 18, 1978. He died as the result of an automobile accident south of Defiance on February 28, 1988, at age nine years, five months and ten days. He was baptized in, and was a member of St. Peter's Catholic Church in Defiance. He was a third grade student at St. Michael's Catholic School in Harlan, and was enrolled in the Pupil Enrichment Program for Gifted Students. He was also a member of the Harlan Wrestling Club.
