

## Ivo L. Gaul, 71

*Sept. 16, 1928 - May 3, 2000*

**EARLING** - Ivo Lawrence Gaul, son of William and Catherine (Schechinger) Gaul, was born Sept. 16, 1928, at Earling. He was baptized and received first communion in St. Joseph's Catholic Church in Earling. Ivo attended St. Joseph's Catholic School in Earling, graduating in 1946.
