Mary Caroline Glihsmann, 54

Aug. 30, 1946 - June 24, 2001

QUEEN CREEK, AZ – Mary Caroline Glihsmann was born Aug. 30, 1946, to Inez Evaline (Merritt) and Otto LaVerne Nelson at their home in Harlan. She was a member of the Harlan Community High School graduating class of 1964. Upon leaving Harlan after graduation, she lived and worked in Omaha, NE, various locations in Colorado, Arkansas, back again to Harlan, California and then finally spent her final days in Queen Creek, AZ.

Aug. 18, 1991, she married James R. Glihsmann. She attended and completed beauty school in Arizona and worked as a volunteer assisting elderly ladies with their hair. She died, unexpectedly, in her sleep at home June 24, 2001, at age 54 years, nine months and 25 days. Her death was due to heart failure caused by hypertension and arrhythmia.

She was preceded in death by her parents. Survivors include her husband, James R. Glihsmann of Queen Creek, AZ; her daughter, Le Anne (Paul) Koppen of Tempe, AZ; her sister, Mickey Williams of Harlan; and other relatives. In accordance with her wishes, Mary was cremated and no formal services were held.
