LEE'S SUMMIT, MO— Russell Arthur Good, or as friends called him, "Poppie", was born in Piqua, OH, April 25, 1908. While working for the railroad, he resided in the Glenwood-Pacific Junction area.

He married Opal Dorsey in Glenwood March 17, 1928. They were the parents of seven children. The Good family lived in Silver City, Pacific Junction and Missouri Valley before Poppie was injured in an automobile accident. He left the railroad and opened a service station in Perry. They moved to the Avoca-Shelby area in the '70's. In 1996, they moved to White Ridge Nursing Home in Lee's Summit, MO. Opal died in 1998. Russell died at the White Ridge Nursing Home in Lee's Summit, Dec. 6, 2002, at age 94 years, seven months and seven days.

Poppie was preceded in death by his parents; his wife, Opal; two daughters, Maxine Hammers and Florence Fritz; one grandson, Phil Fritz; five brothers, William, Robert, Archie, Oscar and Homer; and four sisters, Betsy Hunt, Annie McGlade, Mary Sluder and Alice Good.
