HARLAN — Marty Indrika, 65, of Harlan, died Sunday, June 17, 2012, at his home in Harlan. He was born September 28, 1946, in Pennsylvania and grew up in Wisconsin. He was the first generation born in the United States of Romanian immigrants who came through Ellis Island. Marty graduated from University of Wisconsin-Platteville with a culinary and



history degree. He also did graduate studies at the University of Nebraska-Omaha. He primarily worked in the food industry during his career. He lived in Chicago, Omaha, Fremont, and Portland, Oregon and finally Harlan, working for Village Inn, Bishop Buffet and Hy-Vee. He worked in the bakery department at Harlan Hy-Vee for many years.

Marty married Beverly Thompson in 1972, in Omaha. They had two children. In his life he enjoyed golf, reading, cooking, movies and visiting with his friends at "The 64 Club".

Marty was preceded in death by his parents and is survived by his son Chris (Micki), daughter Rebecca and four grandchildren.
