

## **Lenora A. Ingram, 84**

**May 22, 1914 - Oct. 28, 1998**

**DEFIANCE** - Lenora Amelia Ingram, daughter of Peter and Mary (Kohles) Goeres, was born May 22, 1914, at Defiance. She was baptized and confirmed at St. Peter's Catholic Church in Defiance and attended country school.

Oct. 6, 1937, Norie married Clayton Arthur Ingram at St. Peter's Catholic Church in Defiance. They made their home in Defiance where Clayton operated his own trucking business and Norie took care of the phone calls. After their retirement in 1976, they continued to make Defiance their home. Clayton died Feb. 4, 1988. She was a member of St. Peter's Catholic Church in Defiance. She became a resident of the Baptist Memorial Home Sept. 26, 1995, and has continued to make this her home. It was there that she died Oct. 28, 1998, at age 84 years, five months and six days.
