

Zelma "Babe" Jacobsen, 86

Nov. 9, 1909 - Sept. 7, 1996

HARLAN - Zelma (Babe) Jacobsen, daughter of George Lewis and Margaret Kate Burkett Clark, was born Nov. 9, 1909 at Dawson, where she attended country school and grew to adulthood.

Sept. 20, 1929, she married Harold Jacobsen. To this union one child, Jo, was born. They spent most of their married life in Harlan where they owned and operated a produce business. They also operated a produce in Corley. She worked in the Harlan Bakery for several years. She was a member of First Christian Church in Harlan and a 50 year member of Zenobia Rebekah Lodge No. 286 in Harlan. She lived at the Westridge Apartments, later moving to Little Flower Haven at Earling, and then to the Baptist Memorial Home. She entered Jennie Edmundson Hospital in Co. Bluffs, Aug. 21, 1996, and it was there that she died Sept. 7, 1996, at age 86 years, nine months and 29 days.

In addition to her parents she was preceded in death by two brothers, Carl and John; four sisters, Beulah Clark, Bernice Stofferson, June Hull and Dora Shipp. Survivors include her daughter, Jo Block (Gene) of Harlan; six grandchildren; fifteen great grandchildren; one sister-in-law, Genevieve Jacobsen of the Baptist Memorial Home, and brother-in-law, Harvey Jacobsen (Norma) of Harlan; nieces, nephews and other

relatives.

Funeral services were held Sept. 11, 1996 at Pauley Funeral Home with Pastor John Hester of the First Baptist Church in Harlan officiating.
