Faye E. Jensen, 82 Dec. 19, 1911 - March 16, 1995

Logan - Fave Emma Peterson was born December 19, 1911, the only child of Laura Wilson Peterson and Peter A. Peterson at Oak Park Farm five miles east of Logan. When she was six years old she started to South Whitesboro School, and attended school there for three years and then transferred to Logan Grade School. She graduated from Logan High School in 1930 and that fall she started teaching at Pleasant Hill School in Cass

Township. She taught there for five years.

She married Earnest L. Jensen Dec. 23, 1933. She continued to teach and Ernest hired out to farmers until 1935 when he rented the J.J. Peterson. farm and also farmed Faye's father's farm. After farming there for three years, they moved to the Hoskins farm near Harlan and later to a farm near Kirkman. While in Shelby County Faye was a member of the Farm Bureau County Chorus, Chairman of the Farm Bureau Women's Group and president of the Republicans' Club for two years. She joined the neighborhood women S.I. Club in 1940 and remained an active member until the time of her death.

In 1948 they returned to the J.J. Peterson farm which they bought and farmed along with the P.A. Peterson farm until 1968 when they retired to her father's farm which she inherited. After 14 years they moved to Logan to the Arnel Jensen house which Ernest inherited from his brother, Arnel. She continued to live there until October of 1994, when she became a resident of Westmont Care Center in Logan where she died March 16 at age 82.

Survivors are her cousin, Esther Mertz of Denver, CO and many friends. Services were held March 18, 1995 at the Schumacher Funeral Home with Rusty Hedger officiating. Burial was in the Bethel cemetery near Logan where her Peterson grandparents, her parents and her husband Ernest are buried. Casket bearers were: Gail Dickinson, Rex Fetter, Jeff Surber, Rex Carson, John Straight and Kenneth Leonard.
