HARLAN – Grant Leslie Jensen, son of William and Mary Christensen Jensen was born July 24, 1897 near Manilla. He was educated and raised near Manilla. When he was a young man, his family moved to the Logan area. Feb. 4, 1928, he married Mildred Davis at Logan. They farmed near Logan for 13 years, and in 1941 moved to a farm north of Harlan, where they have resided for the past 48 years. The Jensens were privileged to have been married for 61 years and were members of the Bethel Baptist Church. He died June 27, 1989 at the Myrtue Memorial Hospital in Harlan at age 91 years, 11 months and 3 days.

He was preceded in death by his parents; four brothers: Arnold, Raymond, William and Ernest; two sisters, Myrtle Sunderland and Elvy Jensen. Survivors include his wife, Mildred; three sons: Lowell of Muskogee, OK.; Ronald and Byron of Harlan and a daughter, Mary (Mrs John) Stangl of Marshalltown; by a sister, Hattie Divine of Garland, TX.; 8 grandchildren; ten great-grandchildren; many nieces and nephews and other relatives.

Funeral services were held June 30, 1989 at the Bethel Baptist Church with Rev. Roger Crawford officiating.
