HARLAN — Mary Lorena Slaybaugh Jensen, daughter of James Elmer and Sally (Slueder) Slaybaugh, was born on Aug. 21, 1891, at Springburro, IN. She attended country school in Springburro, IN.

On March 2, 1916, she married James Jensen in Monona County, IN. They were the parents of one daughter and one son. They moved to the Shelby county area in 1919, where he was engaged in farming. After the death of James on Feb. 16, 1948, she continued to live in Harlan where she was a homemaker. She died May 10, 1987, at her home in Harlan at age 95 years, eight months and 19 days. She was a member of the Congregational United Church of Christ in Harlan and the Ladies Aid Society.

In addition to her parents and husband, she was preceded in death by an infant son, James Elmer in 1918, and her daughter, Nadine in 1967; three brothers, Charles, Joseph, and John S., and two sisters, Carrie and Bernice. She is survived by two granddaughters; two great-granddaughters and other relatives.

Funeral services were May 12, 1987 at the Pauley Funeral Home with Rev. John McGee, officiating. Burial was in the Harlan cemetery with Lester Meyers, Clarence W. Smith, Jos. H.
