

Clarence Albert Johnson, 82

Jan. 20, 1910 — July 5, 1992

AVOCA — Clarence Albert Johnson was born in Fairview Twp., Shelby county, Jan. 20, 1910. He was the son of Henry and Bertha Dau Johnson. He was the only child in the family. When he was 8 years old, the family moved to the Johnson farm south of Avoca. He attended school in Avoca and graduated in 1929. He married Ida Thompson Feb. 19, 1940 at Holton, KS. They made their home on the Johnson farm, where he was engaged in farming. They were the parents of one daughter, Linda. He died at his home July 5, 1992, at age 82 years, 5 months and 15 days.
