

Donna Lee (Roecker) Johnson, 54

May 5, 1940 - Feb. 2, 1995

Anaheim Hills, CA - Donna Lee (Roecker) Johnson was born in Harlan May 5, 1940 to Vincent Roecker and Margaret Stoltz Roecker. She attended Harlan Schools and graduated from Harlan High School in 1958 majoring in office education. After graduation she was employed by the School as Secretary to the Superintendent, a position she held for 10 years until moving for a career change and to join her two sisters who were residing in CA. She was employed by Buzza Cardoza and Holmes and Narver as Executive Secretary.

In 1970, she met George Johnson and they were married six months later. Shortly thereafter she joined him in his business - George Johnson Photography. To this union was born a son, Kurt, and at that time she remained home as a full time mother and housewife. She was an active member of San Antonio Catholic Church and a member of the choir, a cantor, and soloist until her ill health prevented her from continuing. She died Feb. 2, 1995.

She was preceded in death by her father and an older brother, Vernon. She is survived by her husband George, son Kurt, both of Anaheim Hills, CA; her mother Margaret Roecker, Harlan, brother Orval Roecker of Harlan, sisters Verla Randall of Harlan and Mary Lou Knight, Anaheim, CA, nieces, nephews and other relatives.

Funeral services were held Feb. 4, 1995 at the San Antonio de Padua Catholic Church, Anaheim, CA. Burial was in the Holy Sepulcher cemetery, Orange Co., CA.
