Kimballton - Hans C. Jorgensen was born April 17, 1904 at Lejerskov, near Kolding, Denmark; the first son of Johan Koed and Mette Kristoffersen Jorgensen. He attended agricultural school and worked on his family's farm in Denmark. He was honored to serve as a royal guard for the Danish Royal Family in Copenhagen.
