GUTHRIE CENTER - Lee G. Jorgensen, son of Jesse and Lilly (Schultz) Jorgensen, was born March 11, 1911 in Mensington, S.D. He was educated in the rural schools of S.D. and Iowa. He worked for area farmers until joining the Army in Jan., 1941. He served during WW II in the 2nd Armored Division. He served from 1941 to Sept., 1945 overseas. He was engaged in several major battles. He started farming for himself after being discharged from the service. Bee keeping was not only a vocation, but also a hobby. He died April 14, 1992, at age 81.

He was preceded in death by his parents and one sister, Alice Babcock. Survivors include his brother, Ralph of Guthrie Center; Annah Jorgensen of Bourbonnais, IL., and Daisy Patt of Westchester, IL., and many cousins.
