

## **Benilda S. Jacoby, 84**

*May 13, 1915 - Nov. 6, 1999*

**OMAHA** - Benilda Susan Jacoby was born May 13, 1915, to Lena (Bissen) and Hubert Jacoby on a farm in Westphalia Township near Earling. She was baptized and confirmed at St. Joseph's Catholic Church in Earling.
