HARLAN – Ila Christine Jorgensen, daughter of Nels and Otilia (Sondergaard) Jorgensen, was born June 29, 1922, in Harlan. She attended school in rural Harlan. She worked as a secretary for the Department of Agriculture for 24 years and two years with the rationing board during World War II. Upon retirement she opened a Danish gift and novelty shop in Harlan. She was also the treasurer for the First Baptist Church in Harlan for many years. She died at Myrtue Memorial Hospital June 20, 1999, at age 76 years, 11 months and 21 days.

She is preceded in death by her parents and is survived by many cousins.
