

## Kenneth Jorgensen, 84

*March 10, 1919 - Sept. 22, 2003*

**ONSLow** – Kenneth D. "Jug" Jorgensen was born March 10, 1919, in Shelby County, to parents Chris and Kathryn (Nymark) Jorgensen and graduated from Harlan High School.

He married Helen Miller April 4, 1943, in Omaha, NE. They had four children. During WWII, he was employed in Omaha at the Glenn L. Martin Bomber Plant. After the war he served in law enforcement in Harlan, then spent many years in the feed and fertilizer industry in Jones County. As an active member of Calvary Baptist Church, Onslow, he served in many positions. He died Sept. 22, 2003, at Jones Regional Medical Center, Anamosa, following a lengthy illness at age 84.
