

MSGT. Kenneth Juhl, Sr., 82

March 6, 1921 - Nov. 27, 2003

COLORADO SPRINGS, CO – Master Sergeant Kenneth Nels Juhl, Sr. was born March 6, 1921, in Harlan, to William E. and Flora (Dale) Juhl.

He married Betty Ann Eby of Bellevue, NE. They were married for 57 years. He retired from the United States Air Force in 1971, after 32 years of military service which included a battlefield commission by the United States Army during the Battle of the Bulge. He was awarded numerous military awards including the Silver Star and two bronze stars for actions during World War II. He had been a resident of Colorado Springs, CO since 1971. He died at a local hospital Nov. 27, 2003, at age 82.

He was preceded in death by one daughter, Diana Mae. He is survived by his wife, Betty Juhl; four sons, Kenneth N. (Catherine) Juhl, Jr. of Omaha, NE; William B.
