Elizabeth Broughton Kasner, 92

June 16, 1899 — Feb. 27, 1992

AVOCA — Elizabeth Broughton Kasner was born near Chicago, IL., June 16, 1899. She was the only child of William H.C. Broughton and Hallie Sheridan. She attended school in New York City and graduated from Mrs Semple's School For Women in 1917.

She married Arthur Kasner Nov. 22, 1922 at New York City. They made their home there until 1938 when they moved to Avoca, which was where Arthur was born and raised. They were the parents of three sons, Edmund, Dana and Jon. She was a member of the United Church of Avoca; P.E.O. Chapter GC of Avoca; the Avoca Garden Club, the American Legion Auxiliary and the D.A.R. Arthur died Nov. 3, 1980. She entered the Myrtue Memorial Hospital in Harlan Feb. 13, 1992 and died there Feb. 27, 1992, at age 92 years.

She was preceded in death by her parents and her husband Arthur. Survivors include her 3 sons, Edmund Kasner (Elizabeth) of Little Rock; Dana Kasner of Omaha, NE.; and Jon Kasner (Karen) of Crofton, MD.; 8 grandchildren and 2 great-grandchildren; and other relatives.

Funeral services were held March 2, 1992 at the United Church of Christ of Avoca with Dr. Robert Houser, officiating. Burial was in the Graceland cemetery in Avoca. Knutson Funeral Home in charge of arrangements.
