KIMBALLTON — Agnes Kristina Kelgor was born July 20, 1905 in Audubon county. Her parents were Hans Peter and Signe (Christensen) Bonnesen. She was baptized and confirmed in the Bethany Lutheran Church, northeast of Kimballton, where she has been a life-time member.

She married Hans P. Nielsen, Feb. 16, 1927, Hans died April of 1961. She continued to live in their home in Kimballton. Then in 1970 she was married to Woersaa Kelgor, also of Kimballton. Woersaa died in 1984. She has been a housewife and has also served as Postmaster in Kimballton for a number of years. She entered the Salem Nursing Home in Elk Horn, April 23, 1987. She died Feb. 4, 1992 at age 86, at Myrtue Memorial Hospital in Harlan.

Preceding her in death were her parents; her husbands, Hans Nielsen and Woersaa Kelgor and James Peter, an infant son. She is survived by one daughter, Betty Marie (Mrs Robert) Sumner of Cupertino, CA.; four grandchildren; four great-grandchildren; three sisters, Esther Burns of Neola; Evelyn Faaborg of Jefferson; Juanita Roache of Hampton; one brother, Elmer Bonnesen of Omaha, NE., and two step-children, Jim (Dorothy) Kelgor of Atlantic and Mary Lee (Mrs Maynard) Durr of Grinnell.
