

Herman W. Kobs, 88

WALNUT - Herman Walter Kobs was born near Avoca, Oct. 9, 1900. He was the son of John and Anna Luth Kobs. He was one of nine children in the family.

He rented a farm seven miles south of Walnut. He married Gladys Mutum on Sept. 11, 1937 at Atlantic. They lived on this same farm for 31 years until their retirement in 1968 when they moved into Walnut. After the death of his wife in 1979, he remained in his own home until July of 1982 when he became a resident of the Matney Morningside Manor in Sioux City.

He died at the Matney Morningside Manor Nov. 27, 1988 at age 88 years.

He was preceded in death by his parents; his wife, Gladys; one brother, Walter Kobs and two sisters, Meta Hines and Ella Moore.
