

Earling - Norbert Anthony Koesters, son of Robert and Theresa (Schneider) Koesters was born Dec. 4, 1905 on a farm near Earling. They have continued to make their home on the farm since his retirement. He was a member of St. Joseph's Catholic Church in Earling.
