MANNING — Margaret, daughter of Adam and Augusta Nieland Stang, was born July 25, 1890 in Washington Twp., Carroll County, IA. She was baptized at the Lutheran Church in Remsen. As a youth she lived with her family on a farm southwest of Halbur. She was confirmed at the Zion Lutheran Church in Manning.

After attending Manning schools she took her Normal Training in Denison and taught rural school. She married Emil Kuhn on Feb. 14, 1922 at Zion Lutheran Church in Manning. They farmed west of Manning, northwest of Aspinwall, and then returned to a farm one mile west of Manning where they remained until after their retirement when they moved into Manning.

In 1982 both Margaret and Emil entered the Manning Plaza Nursing Home. She was a lifelong member of Zion Lutheran Church and was Sunday school superintendent for over 25 years. At the beginning of 1987 her health began to fail and she died Sept. 15, 1987 at the Manning General Hospital at age 97 years, 1 month and 21 days.

She was preceded in death by her parents; five sisters: Mary Sander, Carrie Stang, Lily Barr, Ella Schroeder and Lydia Romney; three brothers: William Stang, Charles Stang and Arthur Stang; and a son-in-law, LaVerne Schroeder.

She is survived by her husband, Emil of Manning; her daughter, Rozora Schroeder of Manning; by two grandsons; one sister, Florence Farrant of Lee's Summit, MO; one brother-in-law of Wall Lake and by nieces and nephews.

Funeral services were held Sept. 16, 1987 at Zion Lutheran Church with Pastor Robert Riggert, officiating. Burial was in the Manning City cemetery with Kyle Schroeder, Chuck Reglein, Jeff Pike, Kurt Schroeder, John Reglein and Art Kuhn serving as casket bearers.
