WESTON, NE – Antoinette M. Kacirek was born June 29, 1909, at Plasi, NE, to Anton B. and Carrie Buresh Fisher. She attended elementary school in Weston, NE, and graduated from Weston High School in 1927. She worked as a postal clerk at the U.S. Post Office in Weston, production laborer at the Nebraska Ordinance Plant in Mead, NE for several years after the end of World War II and at the Campbell Soup Co. in Fremont, NE for several years until her retirement in 1971. She died June 18, 1999, at Little Flower Haven in Earling, where she had resided since 1984, at age 89.

She was preceded in death by her husband, Joseph F. Kacirek, who died Jan. 11, 1975; three brothers, Anton F. Fisher, Joseph J. Fisher and Charles Fisher; and one sister, Lillian Fiala. She is survived by her daughter and son-in-law, Joyce (Schoemann), who taught in the Harlan School system for 25 years, and Lorvey Schwinck of Papillion, NE, and stepsons, George (Lucille) Kacirek of Palos Verdes, CA and John Kacirek of Lake Flathead, MT; two step grandchildren; three step great grandchildren; nieces, nephews and other relatives.
