

Everett Kahl, 86

Nov. 7, 1916 - Jan. 12, 2003

COUNCIL BLUFFS – Everett Kuhr Kahl was born Nov. 7, 1916, south of Walnut in Lincoln Township, Pottawattamie County, son of Ernest and Emma Kuhr Kahl. He attended school in Walnut and graduated with the class of 1934.

Everett married Leah Williams May 5, 1942, in Gering, NE. He was engaged in farming in the Walnut area and also worked at the Omaha Stockyards. They were the parents of two children, Treva and Barry. In 1967, he retired from farming and he and Leah moved to Council Bluffs, where he remained employed at the Stockyards. He was most happy working and after a few other jobs, he took his full retirement in 1981. He died at Mercy Medical Center in Council Bluffs, Jan. 12, 2003, at age 86 years, two months and five days.

His parents and two sisters, Evalyn Reimer and LaVerne Jacobsen, preceded him in death. He is survived by his wife, Leah, of Council Bluffs; his children, Treva Kahl of Bay Point, CA and Barry Kahl (Carol) of Dade City, FL; four grandchildren and one great grandchild and other relatives.

Funeral services were held Jan. 16, 2003, at the Knutson Funeral Home, Walnut, with Pastor Doris Ruben officiating. Burial was in the Walnut Cemetery.
