COUNCIL BLUFFS — Raymond Paul Kasperbauer, son of Boniface and Bernadine (Mersmann) Kasperbauer was born Feb. 6, 1923, in Manning. He graduated from Manning High School in 1939 and attended IWCC for two years. He was a farmer until 1953, worked at the Irwin Sale Barn for two years and the Denison Pork Plant for four years before moving to Council Bluffs in 1969. He was a member of the Catholic faith and the Eagles Club in Council Bluffs. He died Feb. 9, 2007, at Mercy Hospital in Council Bluffs at age 84 years and three days.
