

Allison (Richards) Kenney, 42

HARLAN — Allison Richards Kenney was born in Herlong, CA, Aug. 18, 1959, a resident of California until the age of 5 when her family moved to Iowa. She attended elementary schools in Avoca and Fort Dodge, until her family moved to Merrimack, NH, where she completed her high school education.

Returning to Iowa, she married James Kenney of Fort Dodge, Oct. 17, 1980. Two children were born to this union, Patrick, 15, and Sara, 13.
