## Grace King, 86

*March 9, 1918 - Nov. 11, 2004*

**DEFIANCE** — Grace Louella King was born March 9, 1918, in Manilla, Crawford County to Alvin W. and Tillie G. (Wigg) Cadwell. She was educated and graduated from the Manilla School in 1936.

She worked at different occupations until 1941, when she married Patrick Wolff. Two children were born to this union, Grace Marie (Oct. 31, 1942 - Oct. 19, 1956) and Lawrence Alvin (Aug. 8, 1950 - Aug. 1950). From then on, she was employed in Council Bluffs.

Nov. 14, 1981, Grace married Stephen Austin King. They resided in Council Bluffs until 1986, when they moved to Tennant. In 1990, they moved to Defiance. Stephen died June 1991. She died Nov. 11, 2004, at Myrtue Memorial Hospital at age 86 years, eight months and two days.

Besides her husband, Stephen, Grace is preceded in death by two half-sisters and their husbands, Frank E. and Maud E. Ward and Leslie and Maurine Willson; one half-brother and his wife, Willis S. and Anna Cadwell; two sisters, Mabel and her husband, Guy Miller; and Erma, in infancy; five brothers, Lloyd and his wife, Margaret Cadwell; Vernon A. Cadwell; and Judson, Roy and Ray Cadwell, all in infancy; and one stepson, C.J. (Jimmy) King. She is survived by one sister, Alma (Chris) Yeager of Council Bluffs; one sister-in-law, Edith Cadwell of Des Moines; one stepdaughter, Mary Alice Boudreau of Missouri Valley; four step-grandchildren; one step-great-grandchild; and other relatives.
