

## Myron W. Kington, 88

Sept. 18, 1910 - Nov. 17, 1998

**IRWIN** - Myron William Kington, son of William and Lulu (Graham) Kington, was born Sept. 18, 1910, on a farm near Irwin. Myron was baptized and a lifetime member of the United Methodist Church in Irwin. He attended school in Irwin graduating in 1928.

Oct. 27, 1942, Myron married Evelyn Michels at Defiance. Two children were born to this union: Larry and Mary Lou. He farmed until 1974, when he retired. He also sold seed corn for 30 years and did part time carpenter work. Nov. 17, 1998, he died at Myrtue Memorial Hospital at age 88 years, one month and 29 days.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his sister, Frances, and his brother, Edward; his son-in-law, Norman Ingwers; his stepdaughter, Marcelene Flug, and his son-in-law, Merlin Flug.
