## **Frederick Klein, 89**

**March 12, 1919 - Dec. 1, 2008**

**OMAHA, NE** — Frederick B. Klein was born March 12, 1919, in Harlan, IA to the late John and Mary Klein. He was baptized and confirmed at St. Michael's Catholic Church in Harlan and attended country school in Harlan.
