March 9, 1974 - Sept. 18, 1997

CHARTER OAK - Keevan Andrew Knudsen "Caveman" was born March 9, 1974, son of Jerald and Beverly (Ahrenholtz) Knudsen. He died near Charter Oak, Sept. 18, 1997, at age 23. He was born in Harlan, and was baptized in Christ at the United Methodist Church, Harlan and later confirmed at the United Methodist Church in Charter Oak. He moved with his family to a farm near Charter Oak, where he received his education at the Charter Oak-Ute Community School, graduating in 1992. While in school, he was involved in 4-H and FFA activities.
