NORTH PLATTE, NE – Warren Paaren Kolb, son of Lewis and Elvie (Fiscus) Kolb, was born July 31, 1939, in Harlan, the youngest of two children. He attended school in Elk Horn, and was a member of the graduating class of 1958. He entered into the United States Army in May of 1962. He served in Ft. Leonard Wood, MO, being honorably discharged in November of 1962.

Warren married Sandra Farmer Aug. 10, 1968, at the United Methodist Church in Harlan. One daughter, Leslie Maria, was born to this union Feb. 20, 1970. He worked for five years at a local gas station and later for Harlan Manufacturing for 11 years. He was later employed by Western Engineering.
