

Frederick Kraschel, 84

COUNCIL BLUFFS – Frederick J. Kraschel was born in Harlan. His father, Nelson Kraschel, was Governor of Iowa in 1932. He attended Harlan schools and was a 1936 graduate of Iowa State in mechanical engineering. He attended and graduated from Iowa University in 1939 with a law degree. He served in World War II in the European Theatre with the rank of Colonel. He was a former Pottawattamie County Attorney. He was a member of Delta Theta Phi Law Fraternity, Kappa Sigma Fraternity, Veterans of Foreign Wars, Iowa State Bar Association, Pottawattamie County Bar Association and Association of Trial Lawyers of America. He received the Honor of Merit by the Defense National of Belgium Oct. 10, 1945. He died Aug. 26, 2000, at Glen Haven Home in Glenwood, at age 84.

He is survived by his wife, Mary Louise Kraschel of Council Bluffs; his son, Nelson Kraschel of Clear Lake; and seven grandchildren.

Funeral services were held Aug. 30, 2000, at the Cutler Funeral Chapel in Council Bluffs, with Rev. Scott Foresman officiating. Graveside services followed at the Harlan Cemetery.
