BRANSON, MO. — Nora (Decker) Otto was born Feb. 12, 1911 at Chester, IL. She was married to the Rev. Walter Otto June 7, 1933.

Their married life, until retirement, was spent in Iowa District West. They lived at Woolstock for 5 years, Audubon for 8 years, Yorktown, 3 years, Persia, 6 years, Honey Creek, 13 years and Lotts Creek, 5 1/2 years. In May, 1974, they retired and moved to Branson, MO., where she had resided since Rev. Otto died Dec. 31, 1989. She died Nov. 27, 1992.

She was preceded in death by her husband, Walter; and one son, Lando. She is survived by one son, Walter of Co. Bluffs; two daughters, Janice (Mrs Carroll) Meyer and Sharon Brecke of Branson, MO.; five grandsons; one granddaughter; two great-grandchildren; and four sisters.
